At this time, we have decided to err on the side of caution and close Faith Lutheran Preschool beginning Monday, March 16. We plan to reopen on Monday, April 6.

Our first step in preparedness is to go to our Lord in prayer. We pray for healing for those who have been affected by COVID-19 and comfort for those who have lost loved ones due to this illness. We also pray for an end to the spread of COVID-19.
